DAILY HEALTH QUESTIONNAIRE POLICY
(Updated July 2023)

Thank you for helping to keep our community safe and healthy by reviewing this health checklist everyday (you do not need to complete any forms).

Please note that sending your child, or attending a class yourself, indicates your consent to abide by the health restrictions outlined below and that the student meets the criteria to attend that day. Please read carefully and sign this form.

1. Does the person attending class have any of the following symptoms?

- Cough (not due to other known cause, such as chronic cough)
- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Fatigue in combination with other symptoms
- Fever of 100.0 F or higher, chills, or shaking chills
- Headache (in combination with other symptoms)
- Muscle aches or body aches (not due to strenuous exercise)
- Nasal congestion or runny nose (not due to other known causes, such as allergies and when in combination with other symptoms)
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat

2. Have you recently been in "close contact" with anyone who has COVID-19?

Close Contact is defined as being closer than 6 feet away from an individual who tests positive for COVID-19 for at least fifteen minutes. The infectious period begins 2 days prior to symptom onset. If someone is asymptomatic, the infectious period is considered to begin 2 days prior to the collection of their positive test.

3. Are you experiencing sneezing, sniffing, or coughing due to allergies that will require you to frequently blow your nose during class?

IF YOU ANSWERED YES TO QUESTIONS #1 OR #3 THE STUDENT MUST STAY HOME UNTIL SYMPTOMS LAPSE. Please send an email letting us know of the student's condition.

If you answered YES to Question #2 the student can attend class but must wear a mask and get a Covid test at day 5 and 7 after exposure. If they develop symptoms they need to test at day 5 and 7 after exposure to confirm that their symptoms are not due to Covid, before returning to class.

If a student tests positive for Covid they should isolate for 5 days, afterwards if they are asymptomatic or their symptoms are resolving (without fever for 24 hours) they can return to class but must wear a mask for day 6 through 10.
